
Interested in leading a shooting or archery sport project?

2020-2021 Record Book Update

The 2020-21 Record Book Manual for Members and the related forms are available on the **State 4-H website**.

There are moderate changes to the Leadership Development Report. We added more specific instructions on how to write goals and strategies and added some minimum word requirements to the written sections. There are other minor edits related to the sunset of the Online Record Book. A minor instruction addition on the Annual Project Report about making the "what I learned" statement their own.
