YQCA Program Information - updated!!

All market animal exhibitors need to complete their YQCA training. Make sure you complete it and print out your certificate!

IF you attended the *Washburn Field Day*, in order to get your certificate, you **MUST DO THE FOLLOWING**:

- 1. Complete the pretest in your YQCA profile. If you click on your account, a drop down will have Enrolled ILT Trainings. Click that and the pretest will come up.
- 2. Wait until you are marked complete by the YQCA instructor (this won't happen right away, she will look through them again on March 19)
- 3. Once you are marked complete, you should receive an email from YQCA
- 4. Click back on your profile and complete the post test. Once you complete it, certificate printing information will come up for you.


COLUSA-GLENN FARM CREDIT YOUTH LOANS

4-H Shooting Sports Workshop Rifle Discipline-Tehama County

Saturday, April 1, 2023 – 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Sunday, April 2, 2023 – 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

A 4-H shooting sports workshop for the rifle discipline will be held at the Tehama Shooters Association range in Paynes Creek, CA (20 miles east of Red Bluff). Participants must attend both days of training to

receive certification. Upon successful completion of the course, the participant will be certified as a rifle trainer and can lead a rifle project at the club level or serve as county trainer to certify other leaders. Due to the high demand for Certified Shooting Sports Leaders, adult registrants will be given priority. Teen leaders will be admitted if space allows and must fully participate along with the adults.
